Dear Holdenville Students, Parents, Staff and Community;

Due to the continued number confirmed positive cases of staff members and students over the past week along with the number of contact tracing staff and students being quarantined, Holdenville Schools will be virtual learning through Friday, October 23, 2020. The district will be back in person learning Monday, October 26, 2020

Our first priority is the safety and well-being of our students, staff, and community during this pandemic. We are continuing to work with local and State Health Department officials to address the situation. Each person(s) who test positive with the virus, will be required to follow all CDC and State Health Department quarantine procedures.

The district is following guidelines for trace tracking of contact with the employee and students per Health Department regulations. The district along with the County Health Department officials at that point will determine if students or staff will be quarantined.

Lunches may be picked up at the high school cafeteria between 11:00am and 12:30 pm

COVID-19 is transmitted through person to-person contact and through the exchange of respiratory droplets. As more cases are being confirmed in Hughes County and across the state, it is important to be sensible, but also vigilant in reducing the spread of the virus.
