CORONAVIRUS: PREPARATION TIPS AND RESOURCES

Holdenville Schools will continue to monitor and update information received by the district from State and Federal agencies to our students, parents, staff and community as it becomes available. As we approach Spring Break, remember that you can help prevent the spread of the Coronavirus by taking simple steps to:

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom, before eating, and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
