During the State Board of Education meeting this morning, the board voted to continue the state wide school closure of schools. Holdenville Schools will continue the Seamless Food Program through the remainder of the school year. The time for pick up will continue from 11:00am til 12:30pm. The locations for lunch pickup are listed below.

Over the next 10 days your student's teacher or teachers will be contacting you along with your student to help set up on-line, distance learning instruction. The instruction will become available by April 6th. Each site will list multiple programs the district will be using and monitoring for instruction for your child.

Every site in the district is closed to everyone except authorized personnel.

A schedule of authorized personnel be will listed for each site. The times will be on our Facebook site pages and Holdenville school website along with office hours so that an appointments can be set for pickup of information. You will not be able to enter the buildings! The information will be brought out to you as needed. Holdenville Schools encourage you to work with your child to enhance their educational learning.

Once again this is a very unusual and serious situation. Each day, new information is being released from the CDC, State Department of Health, and the State Department of Education. We will continue to update our community as information is received. Thank you for your support and understanding in these difficult times.
