## SCHOOL LIBRARY MEDIA CENTER

The board believes that library media centers are a fundamental part of the education process. The availability of many materials in a variety of formats presents to students and teachers the possibility of selecting the media best suited for individual needs and modes of learning. Therefore, it is the policy of the Holdenville Board of Education that efforts be made to staff and maintain a school library media center where students and staff members are exposed to a variety of books, periodicals, and references in printed form as well as to a variety of newer communications materials such as filmstrips, films, audio tapes, recordings, etc.

The superintendent is directed to develop regulations governing the selection of materials for and the use of the library media center.
