

AIDS PREVENTION EDUCATION FOR STUDENTS

It is the policy of the Holdenville Board of Education that Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) prevention education will be taught according to the following schedule.

Students shall receive AIDS prevention education:

1. A minimum of once during grade seven
2. A minimum of once during grade nine
3. A minimum of once during grade eleven

The district will use the curriculum developed by the Oklahoma State Department of Education. The general objective of the curricula for all three levels includes being made aware of the:

- A. Forms of the disease
- B. Methods of transmission
- C. Prevention of Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome

The district will make the curriculum and materials that will be used to teach AIDS prevention education available for inspection by parents and guardians of the students who will be involved with the curriculum and materials. Furthermore, the curriculum must be limited in time frame to deal only with factual medical information for AIDS prevention. The district, at least one month prior to teaching AIDS prevention education in any classroom, shall conduct for the parents and guardians of the students involved, during weekend and evening hours, at least one presentation concerning the curriculum and materials that will be used for such education. No student shall be required to participate in AIDS prevention education if the parent or guardian of the student objects in writing to such participation.
