Holdenville Schools will resume to in-person learning Monday October 26, 2020 on our regular schedule. Our first priority continues to be the safety and well-being of our students, staff, and community during this pandemic. We have met all the criteria for quarantine by local and State Health Department officials.

The district has worked very hard to ensure all facilities have been disinfected and sanitized while continuing to serve our students through distance learning. We are still under the mask requirements for all district facilities as we continue to try and reduce the spread of the virus. The district has received some additional cloth masks for students and will distribute as requested by the parent or the student.
