## CHILD NUTRITION PROGRAMS (REGULATION)

In accordance with the Child Nutrition Programs policy of the board of education, the following regulations shall govern the Child Nutrition Program in this district:

- **1.** Any student may eat in the cafeteria or other designated place.
- Students may bring their own meal. Milk or other beverages may be purchased in the cafeteria if desired. Businesses are not permitted to deliver food to students at any time.
- <u>3.</u> Meal prices will be established by the superintendent and child nutrition director, with the approval of the board, at the beginning of each year.
- **<u>4.</u>** Meal prices will be conspicuously posted in each cafeteria.
- <u>5.</u> Use of the cafeteria facilities by non-district organizations or individuals must be approved by the child nutrition director and superintendent.
- **6.** The child nutrition director will develop in-service training programs, approved by the superintendent, for the food service staff.
- <u>7.</u> No persons other than those engaged in preparing and serving the meals are to be in the kitchen at any time.
- 8. No food will be removed from the cafeteria without prior consent from the child nutrition director or the superintendent.
- **9.** Child nutrition employees shall maintain acceptable cleanliness and hygiene standards at all time.
- **10.** Free meals will not be served to any adult, including employees of the district.
- 11. Qualifications for free and reduced priced meals will vary annually in accordance with the annual eligibility schedule.
