

FUNDRAISING POLICY AT SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

Due to the large number of organizations who want to have fund raising activities at school events the following policy will be in effect:

All fund raising at school events must be pre-approved by the building Principal who is responsible for the event. Priority will be given to organizations that support the participants for the event. The Principal shall determine who the other organizations allowed to fund raise at a given event are going to be. In no case shall there be more than three fund raising activities at any one event. ~~not counting the Band Boosters. Band Boosters will run all concessions except Baseball and Softball which will be run by the Baseball and Softball Booster Clubs.~~

Concession stands at all contest will be assigned by the Athletic Director. Each sport will retain 15% of the net profit of which the concessions was ran.

Examples:

High School Football allowed fund raisers will be the Quarterback Club, one high school class, and the Cheerleaders.

High School Fast Pitch Softball allowed fund raisers will be Dugout Club, and two other organizations.

High School Basketball allowed fund raisers will be the Tip In Club and two other organization.

In all cases a request to fundraise will be provided in writing to the supervising Principal in advance of the event. That Principal will determine which organization is approved for which event. This Policy will be in effect beginning with the 2008-09 school year.
